

CENTERING A PDF



Centering a Signature on a larger output sheet is easily done.

In this Example I have created a document 4up on and 8.5" x 11" Step and repeat, w/crop marks and I would like it to be centered and printed on a 9" x 12" sheet.

Note: To see how to create a 2up, 4up and other signatures please review Quite's Technical Sheets.

- 3) To access Quite Imposing Plus, simply select **► Plug-Ins** and then **► Quite Imposing Plus** from Acrobat's Menu bar. Alternately, selecting **► Plug-Ins** from the Menu bar then **► Quite Imposing Plus ► Imposition control panel** as shown here.

- 4) Click **Trim and Shift...** button. *A dialog box will appear.*

Note: In this dialog we will ask you a series of questions and give you options that will work best for the particular job you are running.

- 5) Check **Create a new document instead of modifying this one**

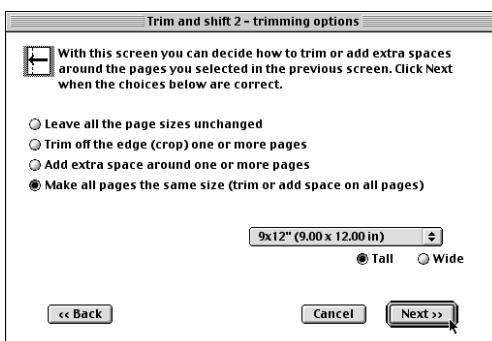
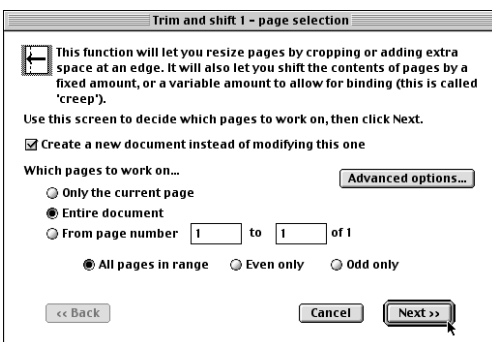
Click **Advance button...**

Select **• 1. Original (Quite imposing 1.0)**

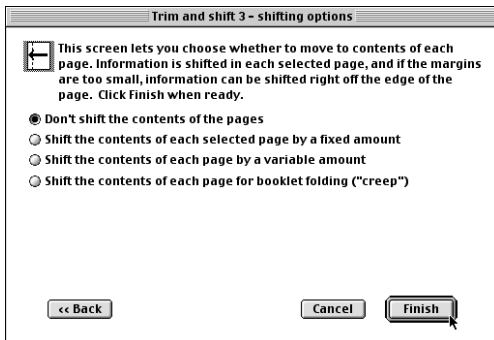
• Entire document
*** All pages in a range**
Click **Next** button

- 6) Select **• Make all pages the same size (trim or add space on all pages)**

Click **Next** button

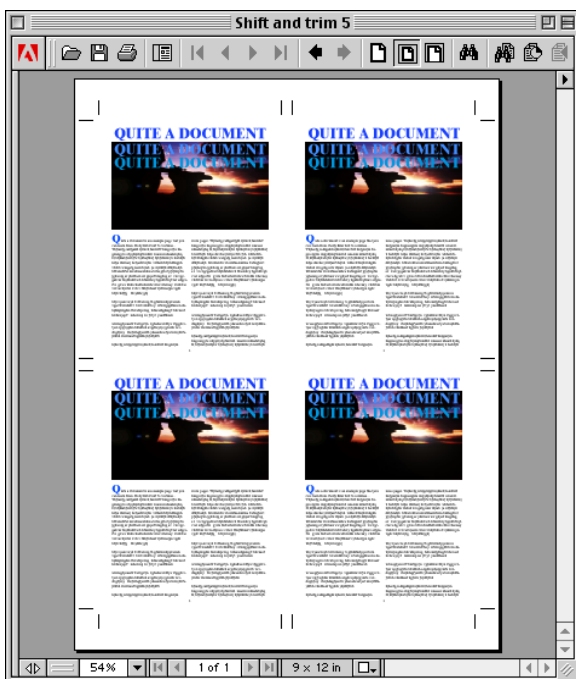


CENTERING A PDF Continued



- 6) Select
- Don't shift the contents of the pages

- 7) Click **Finished** button



- 8) You can now Print or Save your document.
